

Vessel Walkthrough

Starting in the Salon, Port and Starboard Settees are each serviced by a removable center table. The ice-box is accesible from the starboard settee, as well as the cockpit. The sink is on centerline as well as the countertop.

Moving forward, there is a hanging locker to starboard and drawers to port.

Past the main bulkhead is the V-berth with a removable insert which conveniently houses the head. Each side of the V-berth is lit with new brass lamps with adjustable lenses.

All cushions new in 2003.
